



Report on the event ‘Smart Coder Challenge 2.17’ held on 13th September 2017

The Technical Forum of BP Poddar Institute of Management & Technology, Abhiyantran organized ‘Smart Coder Challenge 2.17’, an intra-college technical event on Coding Competition at the Institute Campus on 13th September 2017 during second half (2 pm to 5 pm). The principal objective of the event was to enhance software skill of the students. Each group consisted of two members. Problem statement was provided at the start of the competition and students were allowed to write programs in any programming language of their own choice. However, they needed to complete the task within a given time duration. Total competition was divided into four rounds. Teams were asked to solve one problem in each round and were allowed to proceed to the next round only if they solved the problem of the previous round. Teams which completed more rounds were selected as winners.

The team of Sandipan Saha and Projjal Sengupta secured the first position, Swagato Chatterjee with Ankur Karmar and Abirup Nandi with Saket Didwania grabbed the first runner up and second runner up positions respectively. Dr. Jayeeta Chanda, Associate Professor of CSE Department and Ms. Swagata (Gayen) Kundu, Assistant Professor of IT Department acted as the Judges of Smart Coder Challenge 2.17. Mr. Suvadeep Bhattacharjee (Asst. Prof., CSE), Ms. Gitosree Khan (Asst. Prof., IT), Mr. Subhasis Mallick (Asst. Prof., CA) and Dr. Surajit Mandal (Coordinator, Technical Forum and Associate Prof., ECE) along with five student volunteers conducted the whole event. Technical Assistants of the Computer laboratories (three labs from C Block) also cooperated to make the event a grand success. Regular classes were held as per schedule.
